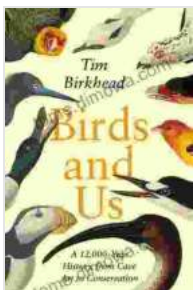

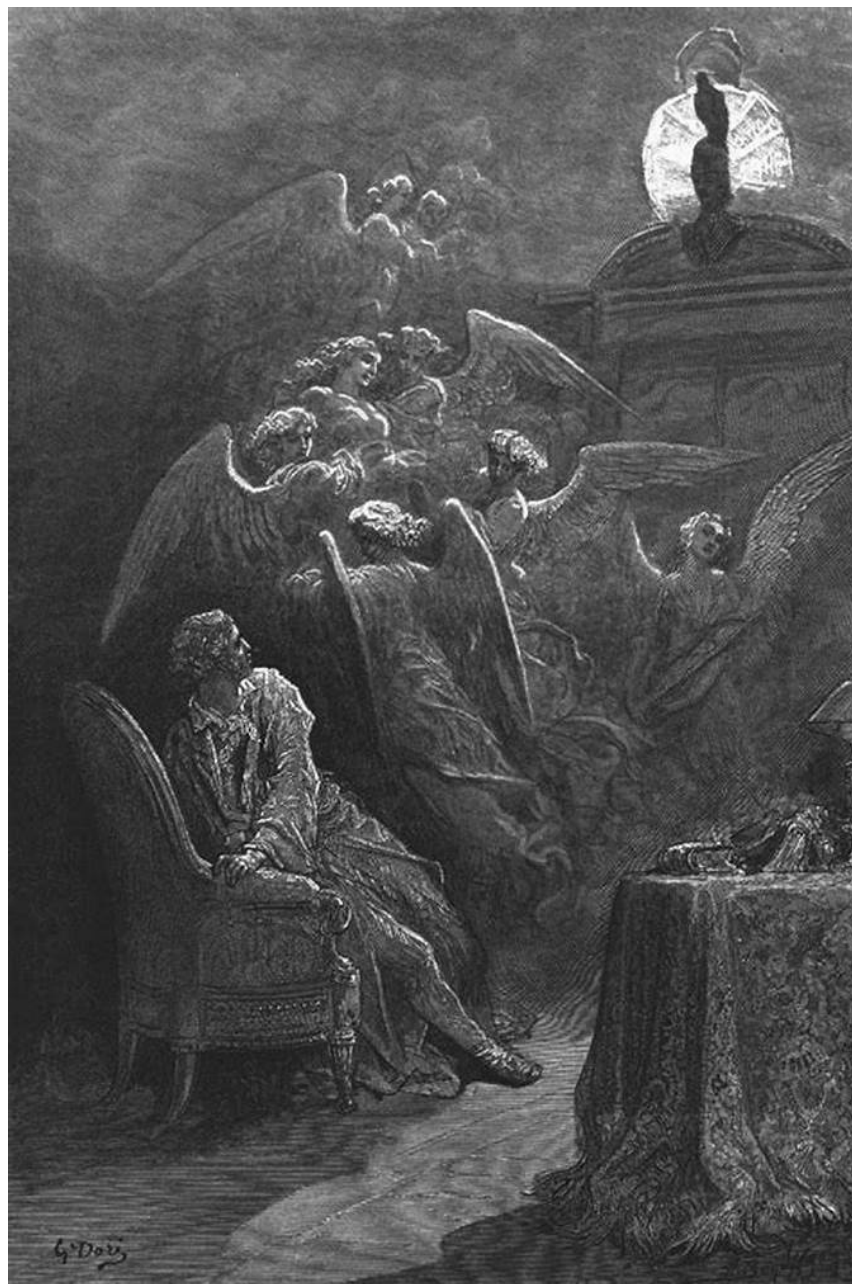


Illustration of a raven by Gustave Doré for Edgar Allan Poe's "The Raven"

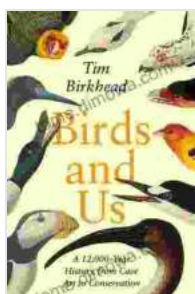
