


Drexler soaring through the air for a thunderous dunk in his Trail Blazers days


Houston Rockets and Hall of Fame Recognition



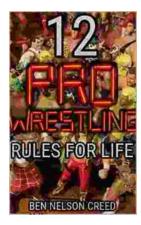
