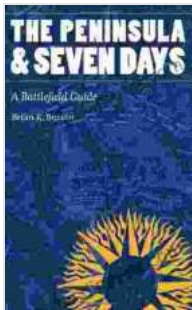

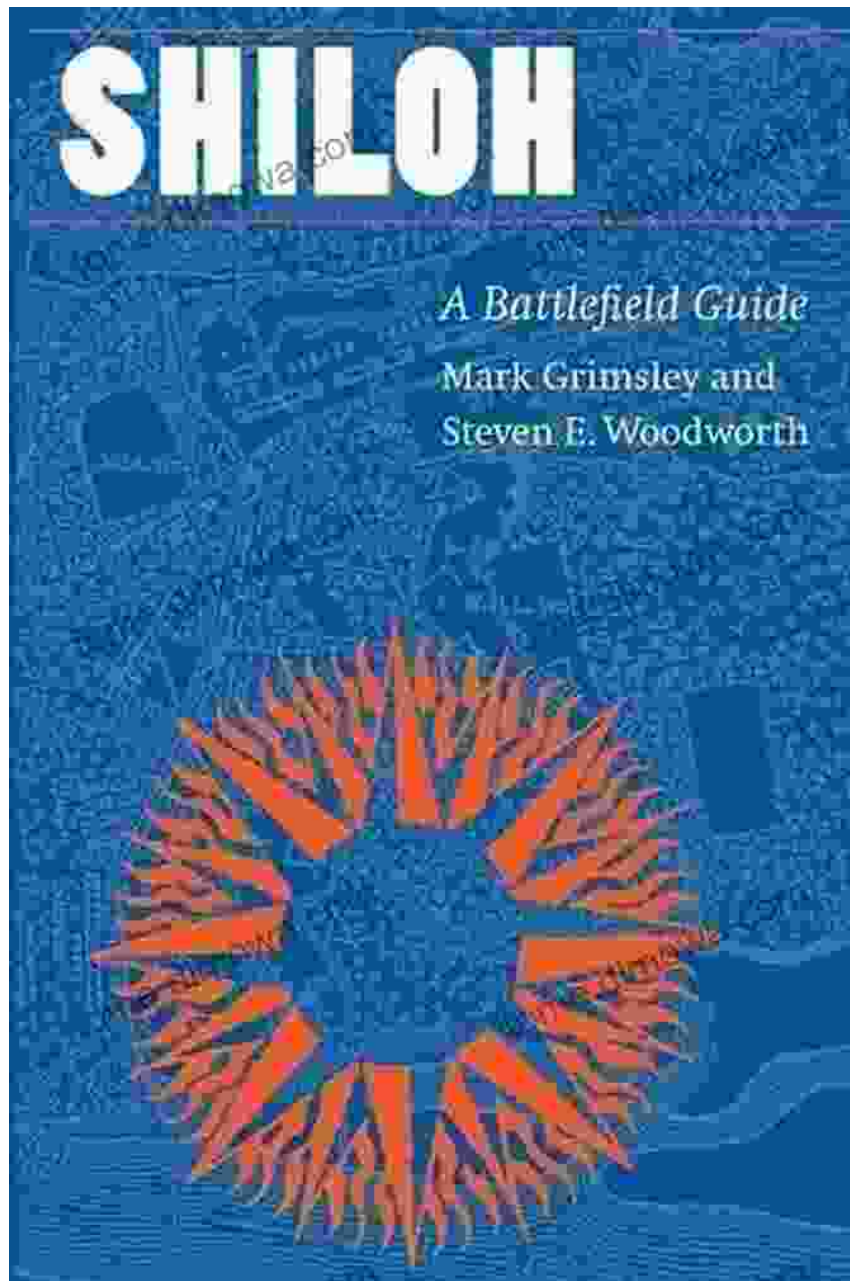

Appomattox

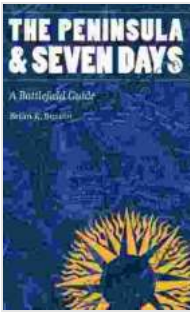
