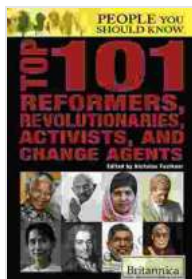

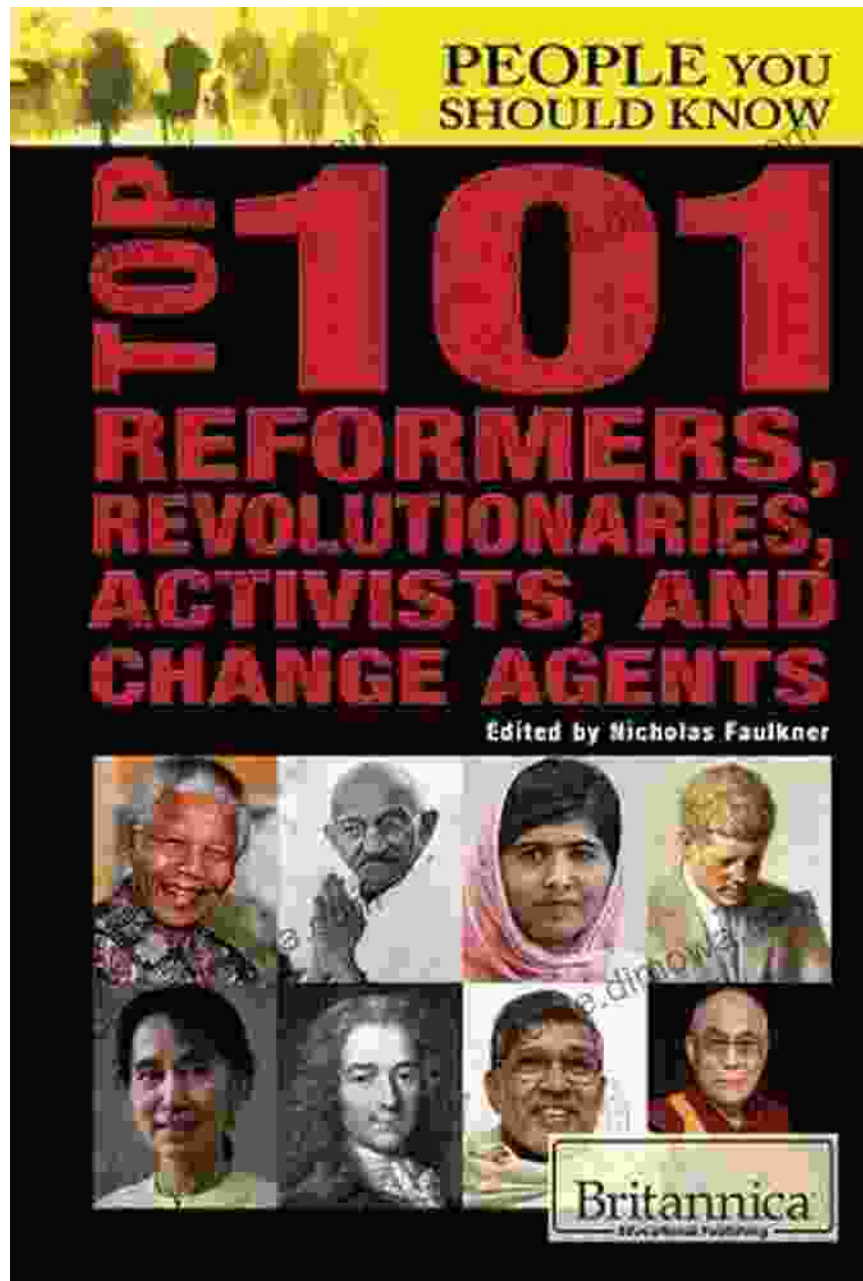

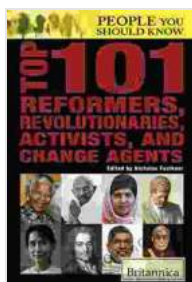
- **Greta Thunberg:** A Swedish teenager who has become a leading voice in the fight against climate change. She has inspired millions of people around the world to take action to protect the planet.
